Queen Kapi'olani Hotel is a four-star retro beach getaway located on the Diamond Head side of Waikiki with unobstructed views of the famed majestic peak of Oahu, and unparalleled access to the beach, park, zoo, aquarium, Waikiki Shell and other nearby gems. Named for Hawaii's beloved Queen Kapi'olani, the property rests on land once reserved for ali'i, or Hawaiian royalty. Queen Kapi'olani Hotel is being renovated and relaunched with a design and curated experiences that are a throwback to the history

of the sun-soaked days gone by of old Waikiki, perfectly complemented by the amenities and comforts of modern aloha. Midcentury modern art and details harken back to the hotel's original opening, while lush views encourage guests to get outside and explore. The property's well-appointed 315 guest suites are amplified by the on-site surf school, an international culinary sensation's first concept in Hawaii, and a collection of vintage Hawaiian and local art that allow guests to immerse themselves in dreamy scenes of midcentury Hawaiiana. Mere steps from Waikiki Beach's white sands and azure waters, and in direct view of Diamond Head's sunset glow and the lush green of the nearby Kapi'olani Park, lies Waikiki's newest lifestyle hotel.

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
